### Installing the KVMMouse Driver

To install the KVMMouse driver, follow the steps below:

- 1 Make sure your Extio system is in Aggregator mode.
- 2 Download the KVMMouse driver from the <u>Matrox website</u> and save the driver to your computer.
- 3 From your Start menu, go to Device Manager.
- 4 Expand Mice and other pointing devices.

If you have more than one device listed (if not, proceed to Step 5), you must determine which one to update. To do so, select **Properties > Details**, then from the **Property** list, click **Hardware Ids.**

## **Uninstalling the KVMMouse Driver**

To uninstall the KVMMouse driver, follow the steps below:

- 1 From your Start menu, go to Device Manager.
- 2 Expand Mice and other pointing devices.
- 3 Right-click on the KVM USB Mouse and select Uninstall device.



4 Select Delete the driver software for this device then click Uninstall.

Windows will uninstall the KVMMouse driver, but you will lose access to your mouse.

5 To regain access to your mouse, press Scroll Lock on your keyboard to open the Extio RX OSD, then disconnect and reconnect your aggregation.

Windows will detect your mouse and it will work with the "HID-compliant mouse" default driver.



The KVMMouse driver is successfully uninstalled.
