

The **Daily Update Service** for our virus database is complementary to our **Complete Version Update Service**, and will permit you to update your antivirus with newly appeared viruses every day. The virus databases for the last thirty days are at your disposal in the calendar below. The virus database is updated daily, so just select the day from the calendar and the corresponding virus database will be downloaded.

We recommend you to make a backup copy of the PAV.SIG file you have in your computer in case of download problems. Once you have downloaded the file to your computer, make sure the size coincides with the file that appears in the calendar. The steps you should then follow, depending on the platform you want to update, are as follows:

DOS/Windows 3.1x: copy the new PAV.SIG file to the directory where you have the antivirus installed. Once copied, reset your computer.

Windows 95: copy the new PAV.SIG file to the directory where you have the antivirus installed and to \Windows\System. Once copied, reset your computer.

Windows NT Workstation 3.51: copy the new PAV.SIG file to the directory where you have the antivirus installed and to \Winnt\System32. Once copied, reset your computer.

If the version of your antivirus is prior to May 1998, just copy the new PAV.SIG to the directory where you have the antivirus installed.

Windows NT Workstation 4.0: copy the new PAV.SIG file to the directory where you have the antivirus installed and to \Winnt\System32. Once copied, reset your computer.

If the version of your antivirus is prior to May 1998, just copy the new PAV.SIG to the directory where you have the antivirus installed.

OS/2: copy the new PAV.SIG file to the directory where you have the antivirus installed.

NetWare Servers: download the antivirus from the server, copy the new PAV.SIG file to the subdirectory of the server where the antivirus is installed and reload the antivirus.

Windows NT Server: stop the "Panda Antivirus Service", copy the new PAV.SIG file to the subdirectory of the server where the antivirus is installed and to \Winnt\System32 and restart the service.

Exchange/Outlook: exit Exchange or Outlook, copy the new PAV.SIG file to \Windows\System if you have a Windows 95 operating system or to \Winnt\System32 if you have a Windows NT operating system.

For Networks: From the update for May 1998 onwards, a file called ACTAPVIR.BAT will appear in the PAVFN directory in the server where the antivirus was copied. By copying the new PAV.SIG to the PAVFN directory on the server and executing ACTAPVIR, the PAV.SIG will be copied to the WIN, WIN95, WINNT and OS/2 subdirectories. In this way, the next time the users connect to the server, this file will be updated.

If the version of your antivirus is prior to May 1998, you must manually copy the PAV.SIG file to all the above subdirectories

RESTRICTIONS:

- Exit the antivirus before copying the PAV.SIG file. If the antivirus is open or in use, the file copy will not be valid.
- The version of the antivirus installed on your computer must be subsequent to January 1998.
