

Connect the system components

Connect the external components to the system unit as shown. If you have additional external components that are not shown in this illustration, refer to the instructions that were provided with those components.

Connect the power cables A. Check the voltage-selector switch to ensure it is set for the voltage for your area. If you are not sure of the voltage in your area, contact your local power company. • If the voltage supply range in your area is 100-127 volts, set the voltage selector switch so you can see 115V or 115. • If the voltage supply range in your area is 200-240 volts, set the voltage selector switch so you can see 230V or 230. B. Connect the power cords to the system unit and any external components (such as a monitor or printer), and then connect the other ends of the power cords to properly grounded electrical outlets. 0 Voltage Selector Switch
